<b>Week 1</b> 1.10	<b>Col 1:15</b> He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. <i>Thank God for Colossae 1:1-8</i>
<b>Week 2</b> 1.17	<b>Col 1:16a</b> For everything was created by Him, in heaven and on earth, the visible and the invisible, <i>Praying for Ya! 1:9-14</i>
<b>Week 3</b> 1.24	<b>Col 1:16b</b> whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him. <i>Jesus@Center 1:15-20</i>
<b>Week 4</b> 1.31	<b>Col 1:17</b> He is before all things, and by Him all things hold together. <i>He Fixed What You Broke 1:21-23</i>
<b>Week 5</b> 2.7	<b>Col 1:18a</b> He is also the head of the body, the church; He is the beginning, <i>Minister of the Mystery 1:24-29</i>
<b>Week 6</b> 2.14	<b>Col 1:18b</b> the firstborn from the dead, so that He might come to have first place in everything. <i>Suffering for Christ's Sake 2:1-3</i>
<b>Week 7</b> 2.21	<b>Col 1:19</b> For God was pleased to have all His fullness dwell in Him, <i>Rooted in Jesus 2:4-7</i>
<b>Week 8</b> 3.7	<b>Col 1:20a</b> and through Him to reconcile everything to Himself, <i>Alive in Jesus 2:8-15</i>
<b>Week 9</b> 3.14	<b>Col 1:20b</b> whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through His blood, shed on the cross. <i>Freedom in Jesus 2:16-23</i>
<b>Week 10</b> 3.21	<b>Col 1:21</b> Once you were alienated and hostile in your minds expressed in your evil actions. <i>Take It Off and Burn It 3:1-11</i>
<b>Week 11</b> 4.11	<b>Col 1:22</b> But now He has reconciled you by His physical body through His death, to present you holy, faultless, and blameless before Him— <i>Put It On and Wear It 3:12-17</i>
<b>Week 12</b> 4.18	<b>Col 1:23a</b> if indeed you remain grounded and steadfast in the faith and are not shifted away from the hope of the gospel that you heard. <i>Christlike Relationships 3:18-4:1</i>
<b>Week 13</b> 4.25	Colossians 1:15-18 <i>Communication is Key 4:2-6</i>
<b>Week 14</b> 5.2	Colossians 1:19-23a <i>Sharing is Caring 4:7-18</i>
<b>Week 15</b> 5.16	Colossians Party

## **Tips for Memorizing Scripture**

- 1. Say a few words at a time over and over out loud. When you get those down, add more words.**
- 2. Write it over and over.**
- 3. Put it on a white or chalk board. Read it over and over. Erase words and read it again until you're able to say it with no words on the board.**
- 4. Put it on a card or several cards that you place in strategic places in your house and/or car.**
- 5. Set reminders on your phone or other devices to remind you to look at and/or recite the verses.**
- 6. Come up with a song, hand motions, and/or draw pictures for key words.**
- 7. Stick with it even if you miss a couple of days or if it takes you a while to get it down.**
